General Instructions for Entrance Examination

Welcome. Please read the following Instructions carefully -

1. If the candidate needs any assistance during the exam, He/she will raise his/her hand and an exam invigilator will come to him/her. The candidate must not leave his/her seat unless permitted by the exam invigilator.
2. It is mandatory to bring Application Receipt given to the candidate at the time of submission of Application form, otherwise he/she may not be allowed to enter the exam venue.
3. The exam will have 100 multiple choice questions (MCQ) and 2 hours to answer them.
4. The questions will be single response objective type. Each answer with correct / nearest correct / most suitable response shall be awarded two marks. Zero mark will be awarded for each question not answered or incorrectly answered.
5. No candidate shall be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Application Receipt, Confirmation Letter, Identity card (without envelope) inside the hall. If a candidate is found to be copying/conversing with other candidates/to have in his/her possession papers, notes or books, or any other material, he/she shall be disqualified from taking Examination and the next one or two such Examinations (as per provision of GUTS rules) and necessary action to be taken as per Gujarat State Physiotherapy Council rules and regulations.
6. The candidate should maintain silence and attend to his/her workstation only. Any disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and the candidate right to continue with examination forfeit. The decision of the Center Superintendent shall be final and conclusive.
7. Pens, paper, mobile phones, electronic/smart watches, any other Bluetooth Devices, books, notebooks, laptops, tablets, camera, bags (in any form) are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.
8. Candidates will remain quietly seated on their seat until the exam invigilator permits them to leave the exam hall.
